Helpful hints for an easy, pleasant stay...



Welcome Pack!

OPEN PLAN LIVING:

We would be very grateful if you would take off your shoes as there is grass just outside and a cream carpet inside!

WIFI - The router is in the hall with the code on the back/bottom of the unit.

TV - This is a smart TV, so the white remote control is used to switch the TV on by pressing the round power button at the top left-hand corner marked TV. Also use this control for the volume. Then press the 'source' button (top middle button) to select HDMI 1. Then switch on the black remote control and use it to change the programs of the FREESAT box.

DINING & COFFEE TABLES As these are easily marked, please use coasters and place mats to protect the surface. Thanks!

LOG BURNER - Please only attempt to use the log burner if you are experienced with this....as this is a wooden log cabin!!! If you are experienced, then please refer to the separate operating instructions provided. We would be grateful if you would clean the log burner and replace any logs that you use.

WINDOWS – You can either use your fingers or use the window key provided on the long chest in the hall. Use this key or your fingers to lift the screws on both side of the window and then, open the lever in the middle and push the window open. It is important to open the lever in the middle only after you have unscrewed the window locks at the sides.



VERANDA – The key to the veranda is the same as the key to the front door.

WASHING - If you would like to air any washing, please put it on the clothes horse that you will find on the shelf in the hall cupboard above the ironing board. If you use the clothes horse outside, please only place it on the veranda below the balustrade so that is hidden from view.

WATER - It is bore hole water supplied from the Estate which we happily drink without filtering but there is also a 'Pure' tap in the kitchen which is filtered should you prefer this.

SINK AND WASTE DISPOSAL UNIT - This is only for soft vegetables, but to be on the safe side, as it is old, please pop any waste vegetables in the bin rather than down the sink. It is important to have water running through the unit when you press the switch (on the wall to the left of the sink) for the waste disposal to clear the sink. If a spoon or anything hard does go down the plug hole, please do not turn on the unit until you have carefully retrieved the item.

DISHWASHER - Please use the quick cycle as it uses less water from the bore hole.

WASHERDRYER – Although it is new, as with most washer-dryers, the dryer is not really effective, so you will find it quicker to dry clothes on the clothes horse or alternatively, the housekeeper can

quote to provide a regular laundry service. Most guests use the laundry service.

RUBBISH

You will see the green rubbish bin for all rubbish which is hidden in the laurel hedge on the road above the path to the log cabin. The rubbish is then recycled at the depot.



WALL RADIATORS - These now run off the regular tariff and we leave then set at a comfortable temperature. Should you want to change the temperature, press the sun button with the red light so that 'Sol' appears on the display and then use the +/- to adjust the temperature. Press the sun button again to set.

FIRE SAFETY PLEASE NEVER COVER THE RADIATORS EVEN WHEN SWITCHED OFF There are fire extinguishers in the kitchen and airing cupboard

IMMERSION HEATER - The hot water is a pressurised system and is on 24/7 providing plenty of hot water throughout the day. Please don't change any switches.

STOP COCK - In the same cupboard as the hot water tank, you will also find the Stop Cock tap on the back left hand side of this cupboard behind the tank. This will turn off all the water to the log cabin.

FUSE BOXES – These are located in the second cupboard from the front door on the RHS as you enter. In here you will find the two fuse boxes that can be opened in the manner shown in the photos.

MAIN BEDROOM – TV – This is the same as the TV in the living room. Wardrobes and drawers are all empty and ready for your use.



SECOND BEDROOM. There is a bed system (single, twin or King size) If you require additional bedding, you will find it in the wardrobe.

VISITOR'S – If you have any visitors please ask them to only park in one of the spaces allocated to the Log Cabin or a parking space where they see a V for Visitor. This is really important for good neighbourly relations! If they cannot find any Visitor parking, then please ask them to park in the golf course car park which is only a short walk away.

HARLEYFORD GOLF CLUB – Here you will also find a bar and restaurant.

LEISURELY WALK INTO MARLOW. You can enjoy a beautiful walk through the estate and along the River Thames into Marlow. It is about 2.5 miles and takes between 45 mins and an hour.



AT THE END OF YOUR HOIDAY....CHECK OUT ...

We hope you have a wonderful stay with us. It would be helpful if you could consider the following at the end of your stay:

- Please strip the beds and put the dirty linen in a pile so that we know what needs to be washed. This would really help the housekeeper.
- If there are any damp things to wash like towels, please leave them hanging up in the bathroom.
- Please dispose of all your rubbish into the communal green dustbin.
- Please place any last-minute crockery or cutlery into the dishwasher.
- Please empty the fridge and freezer and ensure the doors are closed.
- Please ensure all the windows are closed and locked.
- Please lock both doors and leave one key by the WIFI router and the other in the key safe.
